I. APPLICANT PROFILE

Graduates with a bachelor's degree and experience, interested in developing their leadership skills to manage changes with a focus on the sustainable development of organizations. Entrepreneurial individuals interested in diagnosing their company or institution and developing a strategic direction that improves their productivity, growth, and social development.

II. GRADUATE PROFILE

The graduate of this master's program will be a critical, ethical, and innovative leader who will influence the sustainable growth of organizations with a global vision, as well as consistent with the needs of their environment. Capable of managing, directing, and leading organizations with a human sense, while positively impacting their technological transformation and sustainable development in volatile, uncertain, complex, turbulent, ambiguous, and novel contexts.

III. ADMISSION PROCESS & REQUIREMENTS

a) Requirements

- Bachelor's degree studies in any area of knowledge, preferably administration, business, or related fields.
- English proficiency, minimum 460 points ITP TOEFL, or equivalent. Check the accepted English certificates for admission to the postgraduate program available here (Only for applicants from non-English speaking universities).
- Minimum of three years of professional experience after graduating from the bachelor's degree.
- Complete the admission process established for this program.

b) Documents

- Bachelor's degree certificate (translated to Spanish or apostilled).
- Complete bachelor's degree act or evidence of being in process.
- Professional license or proof of application in process. (only for Mexican citizens).
- Birth certificate.
- CURP (only for Mexican citizens).
- Curriculum Vitae in ITESO format, proving a minimum of three years of experience after graduating from the bachelor's degree, available [here](#).
- Letter of intent in ITESO format. With a minimum of 150 words per answer, available [here](#).
- ITP TOEFL (Institutional Testing Program) TOEFL exam from the Educational Testing Service (ETS) in person at ITESO obtain a minimum of 460 points. Schedule [here](#).

c) Application steps

1. Register and complete the admission application, which must be filled out online, available [here](#).
2. Schedule and attend an interview with the program's admission committee.
3. If admitted, you will receive an admission letter.
4. Submit the required original documentation to the Registrar's Office.
5. Once enrolled, you must register your courses in the university's online system.

V. SCHEDULE AND DURATION OF THE POSTGRADUATE PROGRAM

- Core courses are taught between Monday and Friday from 19:00 to 22:00 hours.
- The three skill development workshops are taught over three weekends each, nine weekends in total, with classes on Thursdays or Fridays from 19:00 to 22:00 hours and Saturdays from 9:00 to 12:00 hours.

- Elective courses are taught between Monday and Friday from 19:00 to 22:00 hours, and may also be on Saturdays depending on the current offer of other educational programs.
- Research, Development, and Innovation (IDI) courses are usually taught once every two weeks between Monday and Friday, from 19:00 PM to 22:00 hours.
